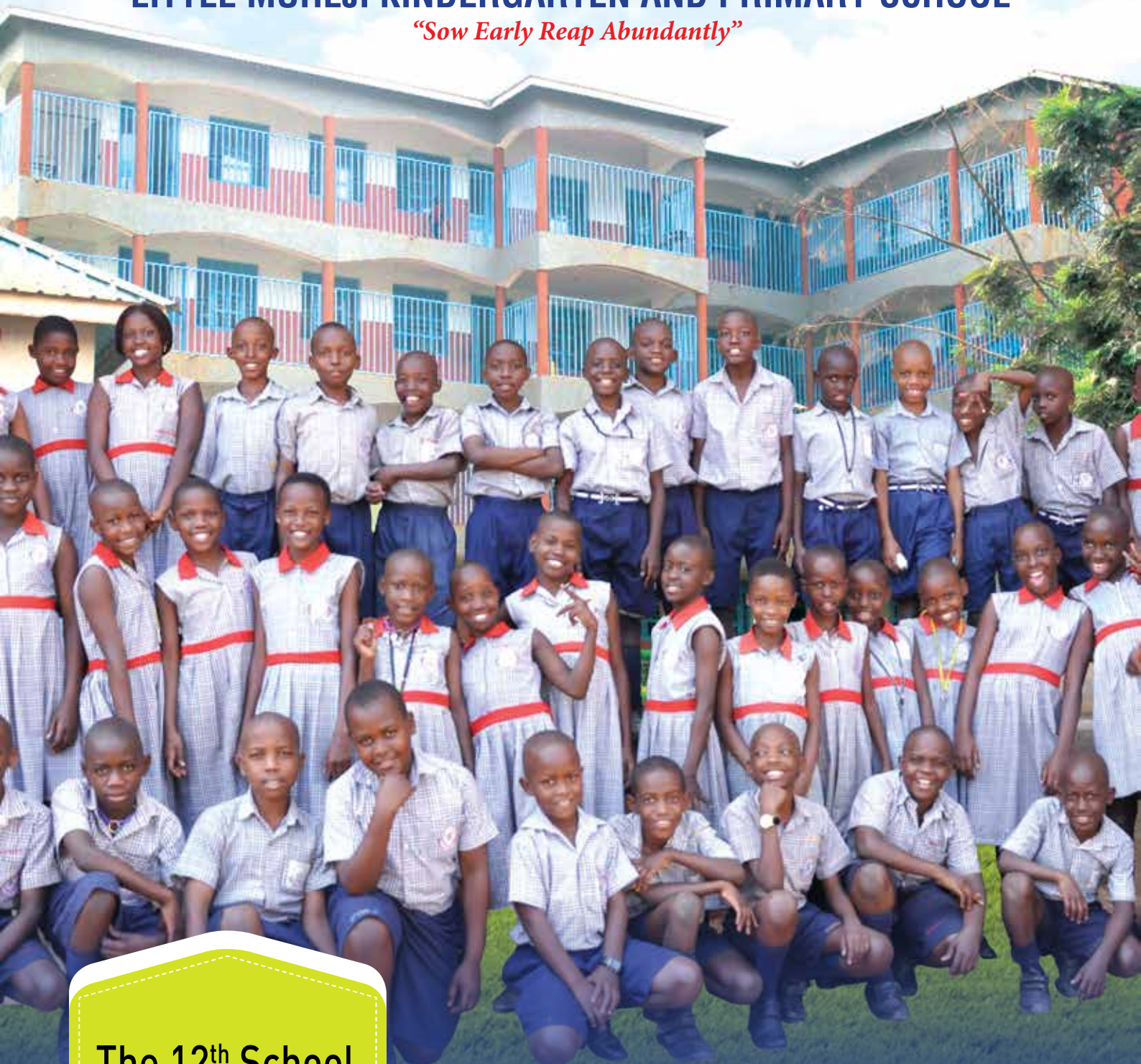

The Sermon by The Rt. Rev. Wilberforce Kityo Luwalira – The Bishop Namirembe Diocese

PRESENTATION AND EXAMINATION OF CANDIDATES

Priest: Father in God, we bring to you these people who have been baptized so that you may confirm and commission them for the mission of Christ and His Church.

Bishop: Take care that these people you have presented to me for confirmation have been instructed in Christian faith, and fully understand their baptism vows and are willing to serve Christ and His Church.

Priest: We have instructed and examined them and found them worthy.

Bishop: Do you who are gathered here agree that these people be confirmed and commissioned for the mission of Christ and His Church?

All: We agree

(Bishop turns to the Candidates)

BISHOP TO CANDIDATES:

Bishop: You have come here to be confirmed. You stand in the presence of God and His church. Our Lord Jesus Christ gave himself to death on the cross and was raised again for salvation of human kind.

Baptism is the sacrament in which, by repentance and faith we enter into his salvation; we are united with Christ in his death: we are granted the forgiveness of sins, we are raised with him to new life in spirit. In confirmation, we come to be filled through the laying on of hands, with power of the spirit to worship, witness and service. With our own lips and from your own heart you must renew the vows of baptism and declare your allegiance to Christ and your rejection of all that is evil. Therefore, I ask these Questions.

(Candidates respond three times to each question)

Bishop: Do you turn to Christ?

Answer: I turn to Christ **x 3**

Bishop: Do you repent of your sins?

Answer: I repent of my sins **x 3**

Bishop: Do you renounce Satan, his work and all powers that manifest through his work?

Answer: I renounce them all. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you be willing to tell your neighbors' about the love of Christ?

Answer: I will. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you pray and support the Church, the Bishops, Clergy and all other church work?

Answer: I will do so God being my helper. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you read the Bible regularly and fashion your life after it?

Answer: I will diligently do so **x 3**

Bishop: Will you endeavor to meet with other Christians for fellowship and stir up the gift of God that is in you?

Answer: I will endeavor to do so **x 3**

Bishop: Will you endeavor to feed the hungry, give water to the thirsty, welcome strangers in your home, clothe the naked, care for the sick and visit the prisoners?

Answer: I will do so, with God's help. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you pray and support the lonely, orphans, widows and the voiceless?

Answer: I will pray and support them. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you endeavor to be a good steward of God's creation and care for the environment?

Answer: I will endeavor to do so. **x 3**

Bishop: Will you be alert, watchful and resist your enemy, the devil firmly?

Answer: I will do so the Lord being my helper. **x 3**

Bishop: Do you believe and trust in God the Father who made the world?

Answer: I believe and trust in Him. **x 3**

Bishop: Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ who redeemed mankind?

Answer: I believe and trust in Him. **x 3**

Bishop: Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit our guide and comforter?

Answer: I believe and trust in Him. **x 3**

(Then the Bishop turns to congregation and says)

Bishop: This is the faith of the church.

All: This is our faith, we believe and trust in one, father and the Holy Spirit.

Bishop: Lord hear our prayers.

All: And let our cry come to you.

Bishop: Our help is the Name of the Lord.

All: Who has made heaven and earth

Bishop: Blessed be the name of the Lord.

All: Now and forever. **Amen**

(While stretching out his hands towards the Candidates, the Bishop says)

Bishop: Almighty and everlasting God, you have given your servants new birth in Baptism by water and Holy Spirit, and have forgiven them all of their sins. Let your spirit rest upon them;

The Spirit of wisdom and understanding;

The Spirit of Counsel and inward strength;

The Spirit of knowledge and true godliness;

And let their delight be in the fear of the Lord. **Amen.**

School Kindergarten



Little Muheji Kindergarten school that opened her doors in 2006, was a long dream that started in 1998 with discoveries in Secondary education, and later in 2004, a piece of land was procured, construction initiated and completed in September 2005, paving way for the start of the school on 6th February 2006. Little Muheji School was set up by development oriented Ugandans having realized the dire need to provide relevant, quality, efficient and effective Kindergarten, and daycare services in the outskirts of Wakiso Town. The school

was primarily set up to only offer kindergarten services, however, when the pioneers completed Top Class, there was demand to start the primary section. The Kindergarten admits children aged 3 and above. It covers Baby, Middle and Top Classes. All the classes are streamed to manageable numbers to ensure an excellent pupil teacher ratio. Each of the streams is handled by at least two teachers. We have very experienced and compassionate teachers in the school with the aim of making children love school.

Primary Section

The pupils that graduated from Top Class joined primary one in 2007 and this cohort is our pioneer that completed their Primary Leaving Examination in 2013. Indeed, 2013 was a historical year as our pioneers scored the 7th position in Wakiso district and the 34th in the Country. The primary campus provides a full range of academic and co-curricular activities. Like in the kindergarten section, the

School Curriculum

Little Muheji School provides a curriculum that accepts pupils aged three to Five for Kindergarten and from age Six for Primary section following the Ugandan education system. We have a broad and balanced curriculum which provides for the academic, spiritual, moral, physical, creative, personal, and social development. This will stimulate your child to acquire knowledge and develop individual skills. The syllabus covers the Uganda National Examinations Board syllabus (UNEB). This will provide a solid foundation for the next stage in their education. The children are taught in

their group by subject specialist teachers. Each group also has a class teacher who will get to know your child very well, to understand the best approach in helping them learn and understand. Assessments of development and learning needs are done throughout the school year. The assessment for all pupils in primary classes is an ongoing process. Pupils are assessed on monthly tests, beginning, mid and end of term tests and holiday packages are also considered. These assessments are a blend of internally and externally set examinations, and promotion at the end of the year is based on the cumulative pass mark of the school.

Boarding facilities:

The school has excellently established permanent boarding facilities separate for boys and girls. The facilities are equipped with CCTV Cameras, fire extinguishers, escape doors, both hydro and solar electricity thunder arrestors and running water. Boarding facilities were primarily established for upper primary i.e from P.5 to P.7 and not compulsory. But provision has also been made for children in lower primary who for one reason or other may require these services.

The school provides transport as a complementary service for parents and guardians that may not be able to pick and drop their children from the school.
